


WHAT TO EXPECT:

THE TUTORS



George Gunn, a poet, playwright, and essayist from Caithness, is now based in Thurso. He has written over fifty stage and radio plays, produced for BBC Radio Scotland and Radio 4, and founded Grey Coast Theatre Company to champion Highland voices. Author of numerous poetry collections, the novel The Great Edge, and essays for Bella Caledonia, he is currently the Caithness Makar and creating Words on the Wind, a poetry-film project with Lyth Arts Centre. Gunn has also worked at sea on trawlers and oil rigs.



Gerda Stevenson is an award-winning Scottish writer, actor, director, and singersongwriter. She has worked across stage, screen, radio, and opera, and is a BAFTA-winning actress and founder of Stellar Quines theatre company. Her acclaimed works include the play Federer Versus Murray, the poetry collections If This Were Real and Quines, and the short story collection Letting Go. She has also been nominated Scots Singer of the Year for her album Night Touches Day.



Laura Cameron-Lewis is a Scottish multidisciplinary artist, writer, and musician. A former member of the band Swimmer One and creator of the music project The Keening, she works across theatre, film, and performance, often blending storytelling with sound and visual art. She has led cultural projects such as The Work Room and community-rooted festivals, creating work that explores place, memory, and human connection.
